Name on the plot map is Joseph Gray

1. Joseph Gray was born in Halifax, Nova Scotia on July 5, 1836. He was a fisherman, and arrived in the United States in 1857. He is not buried in Oak Grove with his second wife. He died between 1870 and 1880. He is probably the Joseph Grey who drowned when the Schooner Robert Emmett went down in December of 1876.
2. Emma W Gray was born in Chester, Nova Scotia in 1834. Her maiden name was Hutt. Her father was George E Hutt (born in England) and her mother was Sophia Ivroner (born in Canso, Nova Scotia). She died on December 12, 1863 and has the only marker in the plot.
3. Joseph Hutt was born in Canso, Nova Scotia in 1821. It seems likely that he is connected to Emma, possibly a brother. He died in Gloucester in April of 1868.
4. James S. Gray was the son of Joseph's brother, Samuel and his wife Mary King. He was born on July 27, 1870 to a mother who was dying of Consumption. He died a month after she did. He died on October 16, 1870.
