2. George W. Lewis was the son of Robert and Susan Lewis. He was born in 1844. He enlisted in Company K of the 12th Infantry Regiment on June 26, 1861 and mustered out on December 28, 1863. He died of smallpox on January 25, 1864. He has a military headstone which was recently repaired and is in fair condition.
3. William Winthrop Sargent was the son of Jonathan Sargent and Patience Tucker. He was born in Gloucester on Jan 10, 1819. He married Charlotte Marchant in Gloucester on January 10, 1819. He died in Gloucester on June 23, 1881.
4. Eliza Sargent Ingalls was the daughter of Winthrop Sargent and Charlotte Marchant. She was born in Gloucester on November 8, 1826. She was married to William Ingalls. She died in Gloucester on April 27, 1916.
5. Eliza Ingalls was the daughter of Eliza and William Ingalls. She was born in Gloucester on Aug 13, 1857. She died there on July 7, 1881.
6. George P. Ingalls was the son of Eliza and William Ingalls. He was born in Gloucester in 1865 and died there on February 27, 1874.
7. John H. Ingalls was the son of Eliza and William Ingalls. He was born in Gloucester on January 21, 1855 and died there on March 20, 1933.
8. Charlotte Marchant Sargent was the daughter of William Marchant and Sarah "Sally" Rowe. She was born in Gloucester in 1802 died there on August 13, 1868.
