Plot owner's name is Richard Herrick

1. Richard Herrick was the son of Richard Herrick and Thankful Rust. He was born in Gloucester on August 22, 1823. He married Elretta Sargent on April 16, 1850. His mother died in 1880 and his wife in 1881. He may have been very despondent because he hung himself on January 15, 1883.
2. Elretta Sargent Herrick was the daughter of Winthrop Sargent and Charlotte Merchant. She was born in Gloucester on May 9, 1832. She died in Gloucester on March 28, 1881.
3. John J. Herrick was the son of Richard and Elretta. He was born in Gloucester on August 3, 1857. He married Flora Elvira Lurvey on October 10, 1877. He died in Gloucester on January 15, 1935.
4. Flora Elvira Lurvey Herrick was the daughter of William Lurvey and Elvira Lowe. She was born in Rockport on February 10, 1851. She died in Gloucester on May 7, 1913.
5. Arthur Herrick was the infant son of Josiah Herrick and Gertrude Stuart. He was born in Gloucester on February 1, 1898 and died the next day. His great grandfather was Winthrop Sargent and his great aunt was Elretta. Winthrop has family connections to several plots in Clark's Cemetery. The baby could also be buried where Winthrop is buried.
6. Elsa Herrick Ames was the daughter of John J. Herrick and Flora Lurvey. She was born in Gloucester in 1879 and married Albert Ames in 1899. She died in Gloucester on July 25, 1902.
