1. George W. Collum was born in 1828 in New Haven, Connecticut. He was the son of John and Mary Collum. He married Fannie Ayers in Gloucester on September 3, 1852. He was a tinsmith, as was his father. He died in Hampton, New Hampshire on February 1, 1907.
2. Fannie Ayers Collum was born in Gloucester in 1829. She was the daughter of John Ayers and Sarah Spiller. She died in Hampton, New Hampshire on April 5, 1904. She and her husband chose to be buried in Clark's with their children who predeceased them.
3. Fannie Collum was the baby girl of George and Fannie Collum. She was born in Gloucester in 1864 and died there on September 9, 1864.
4. Howard W. Collum was the son of George and Fannie. He was born in Gloucester in 1874 and died there on April 8, 1874
5. Caroline "Carrie" Collum was the daughter of George and Fannie. She was born in Danvers on February 20, 1862. She has a broken up piece of a tombstone. She died of burns in Gloucester on May 14, 1875.
