Josiah W. Stevens is the name on the plot map.

1. Josiah Witham Stevens was the son Joseph Stevens and Hannah Witham. He was born on November 21, 1791 in Gloucester. He married Alice Clark on September 10, 1820. He was living in the Gloucester Almshouse in 1870 and died on February 5, 1874.
2. Alice Clark Stevens was the daughter of John Clark and Martha Sargent. She was born in Gloucester on March 17, 1794 and died there on June 8, 1863.
3. Josiah Stevens was the son of Josiah and Alice. He was born in Gloucester on August 27, 1822. He married Elizabeth S. Potter in Topsfield on February 17, 1845. She was the daughter of John and Harriet Potter. She died in Ipswich from an infection after childbirth on February 23, 1853. Josiah next married Luthera W. Chapin on June 19, 1862. He was a Civil War veteran and a member of the G.A.R. He died in Gloucester on May 18, 1903.
4. Charles Henry Stevens was born in Topsfield to Josiah Stevens and Elizabeth Potter. He was born August 18, 1845. He died in Topsfield about three weeks after his mother on March 17, 1853.
5. Alice Stevens Brown was the daughter of Josiah Stevens and Luthera Chapin. She was born on May 24, 1877 in Gloucester. She married Elmer V. Brown on April 4, 1899. She died due to a miscarriage in Gloucester on March 3, 1903.
6. Luthera W. Chapin Stevens was born in N. Montpelier, Vermont in 1835, the daughter of John A. and Deidamia Chapin. She died in Gloucester on January 3, 1909.
