Joseph Brooks is the name on the plot map.

1. Joseph Brooks was born in Weymouth, Nova Scotia in 1842. He was the son of Peter Brooks and Martha Cook. He married Emily Augusta Perkins in Gloucester on April 4, 1863. He died in Gloucester on March 4, 1893.
2. Emily “Emma” Augusta Perkins Brooks was the daughter of Alcott Perkins and Jane Powers. She was born in Gloucester on November 10, 1845. She died there on September 29, 1894.
3. John F. Brooks was the son of Joseph and Emma Brooks. He was born in Gloucester on July 11, 1880 and died there on October 19, 1896.
4. Joseph A. Brooks was the son of Joseph and Emma Brooks. He was born in Gloucester on July 13, 1869. He married Josie D. Cook on January 1, 1889. He died of pneumonia in Gloucester on October 29, 1892.
5. Lizzie M. Brooks was born in Gloucester on February 10, 1877, the daughter of Joseph and Emma Brooks. She died in Gloucester on December 19, 1880.
6. Peter C. Brooks was the son of Joseph and Emma Brooks. He was born in Gloucester on November 14, 1884 and died there on Dec 6, 1911.
7. Cornelius Brooks is the only family member with a tombstone. He served in Company D of the Massachusetts Infantry, 57th and 59th Regiments. He was the son of Peter Brooks and Martha Cook and the brother of Joseph. He was born in Weymouth, Nova Scotia on March 10, 1847. He arrived in America on June 15, 1862. He married Frances Ann Cook on December 27, 1869. He was fatally injured in a collision of ships in Boston Harbor. He died on October 20, 1899.
8. Frances Ann Cook Brooks was the daughter of Francis and Susan Jane Cook and the wife of Cornelius. She was born in Nova Scotia in 1857 and died in Gloucester on July 25, 1885.
