Name on Plot Map is George L. Burnham

1. Amos Woodbury was the son of Joshua Woodbury and Sarah Babson. He was born in Gloucester on February 9, 1795. He married Harriet Herrick on November 21, 1816. He died in Gloucester on June 12, 1862.
2. Harriet Herrick Woodbury was born in Gloucester on January 9, 1798. She was the daughter of Josiah Herrick and Rachel Williams. She died in on April 22, 1852. There is a partial oval plaque that says "Mother".
3. Sydney Woodbury was the son of Harriet and Amos. He was born in Gloucester on August 25, 1836. He died in a tragic train accident in Wenham on September 17, 1862. He has a fine monument.
4. Harriet Osgood Woodbury Reed was the daughter of Amos and Harriet. She was born in Gloucester on December 8, 1823. She married Thomas Lyons Reed on March 23, 1849. she died in Gloucester on Aug 21, 1851. Her son was Thomas Sidney Reed. There is a small oval plaque that is broken in pieces that says "Harriet".
5. Mary Ann Woodbury Burnham was the daughter of Amos and Harriet. She was born in Gloucester on April 23, 1831. She married George L. Burnham on October 20, 1853 and died in Gloucester on March 21, 1879. Her monument is broken, but has been glued back together with one piece of marble missing.
6. John Woodbury was born in Gloucester on November 6, 1821. His parents were Amos and Harriet. He died in Gloucester on January 18, 1872.
7. Augusta Woodbury Logan was the daughter of Amos and Harriet. She was born in Gloucester on September 5, 1826. She married John L. Logan on November 26, 1854 and died of Consumption in Gloucester on December 4, 1854 (days after her marriage).
