B. Porter is the name on the plot map.

1. Benjamin Porter was born in New Brunswick, Canada in 1829. He was the son of Henry Porter and Charlotte Noe. He married Elizabeth Matthews in Maine in about 1853. He moved to Gloucester in about 1871. He died in Gloucester on February 2, 1892.
2. Elizabeth Matthews Porter was the daughter of Ivory and Elizabeth Matthews. She was born in Maine in 1830 and died in Gloucester on January 25, 1914.
3. Baby Girl Porter was the daughter of Benjamin and Elizabeth. She was born in Gloucester on July 11, 1872 and died there on November 1, 1872.
4. Henry A. Porter was the son of Benjamin and Elizabeth. He was born in 1862 and died in Gloucester on March 13, 1898.
5. Linnie R. Porter was the daughter of William C. Porter and Naomi Melvin and the granddaughter of Benjamin and Elizabeth. She was born in Gloucester on January 30, 1888 and died there Aug 21, 1888.
6. Lillie F. Porter was the daughter of Wellington and Lydia Porter. Wellington was probably the brother of Benjamin and therefore Lillie was his niece. Benjamin named a son after Wellington (an unusual name). She was born in Gloucester in 1863 and died there on February 3, 1878.
7. Alexander Grant was the son of Peter Grant and Sarah Musgrave. He was born in Sydney, Cape Breton, Nova Scotia on April 18, 1830. He served in Company D, Massachusetts 32nd Infantry Regiment from December 13, 1861 to December 28, 1864. He was married to Eliza Murphy with whom he shared the sorrow of burying many children. He died in Gloucester on July 1, 1898.
8. Eliza Murphy Grant was born in New Brunswick in 1830. She was the daughter of Walter Murphy and Hannah Neil. She died in Gloucester on January 7, 1901.
9. Alexander Walter Grant was called Walter rather than Alex. He was the son of Alex and Eliza Grant. He was born on September 18, 1858 and died in Gloucester on January 1, 1859.

10. Alonzo Grant was the son of Alex and Eliza. He was born in South Boston In 1854. He drowned in Gloucester on July 5, 1868.
11. Frank Grant was the son of Alex and Elizabeth. He was born in Gloucester on October 7, 1859. He succumbed to scarletina on March 2, 1864.
12. Theodore William Grant was the son of Alex and Eliza. He was born on November 23, 1865 in Gloucester. He was a single man and was found dead in his bed, (probably epilepsy) on May 14, 1906.
