She next married William Carr on January 12, 1867. She died of consumption in Gloucester on May 8, 1874.
2. William Carr was the son of John Carr and Catherine Carter. He was born in Canso, Nova Scotia in 1841. He was a mariner. He died of dropsy in Gloucester on September 20, 1870.
3. Carrie M. Carr was the daughter of William and Mary E. Carr. She was born in Gloucester on August 12, 1867. She died of consumption on August 7, 1869.
4. John W. Carr was the son of William and Mary E. Carr. He was born in Gloucester on October 29, 1870. He died of cholera infantum on May 23, 1871.
