1. Frederick Ellsworth Hunt was born in Northfield, Franklin County, Maine on April 20, 1803. He married Eliza Kilburn Smith on October 1, 1825 in Londonderry, Rockingham County, New Hampshire. He died in New Orleans, Louisiana in 1840
2. Eliza Kilburn Smith Hunt was born in Gloucester on September 3, 1802. She died there on November 22, 1840. She was the daughter of Nathaniel Smith and Anna Kinsman Smith.
3. Ann Electa Hunt was the daughter of Frederick and Eliza. She was born in Derry, New Hampshire in 1827. She died of Consumption in Gloucester on March 5, 1855.
4. Susan E. Hunt Breed was the daughter of Frederick and Eliza. She was born on January 11, 1839 in Massachusetts. She married Albert Horatio Breed on Aug 25, 1879 in Portland, Maine. She died in Lynn, Massachusetts on May 24, 1918.
5. Abigail "Abbie" Smith Hunt was the daughter of Frederick and Eliza. She was born in 1833 and died in Gloucester on December 4, 1841.
6. Susan Kinsman was the daughter of Nathaniel Kinsman and Abigail Eveleth. She was born in Gloucester in 1780 and died on August 2, 1862 in Gloucester.
7. Captain Nathaniel Smith is on the marker under his wife's name, but he is buried in First Parish.
8. Anna Kinsman Smith was the daughter of Nathaniel Kinsman and Abigail Eveleth. She was baptized in Gloucester on February 26, 1775. She married Captain Nathaniel Smith in Gloucester on January 7, 1799. She was the sister of Susan Kinsman. She died in Gloucester in 1804.
