1. David Lufkin's name is on the tombstone, however he is actually buried in Chalmette National Cemetery in Louisiana. He enlisted in Company K of the 30th Massachusetts Infantry on January 14, 1862. He died in service to his country on August 12, 1862. He was the son of Samuel Lufkin and Judith Saunders. He was born in Gloucester on November 5, 1821. He married Eliza Blatchford on February 25, 1847.
2. Eliza Blatchford Lufkin was the daughter of Samuel Blatchford and Eliza Rowe. She was born in Gloucester on March 3, 1829 and died there on December 2, 1869. In addition to losing her husband, she buried at least 7 of her children. The following are their children.
3. Frances Augusta Lufkin was born in Gloucester on August 12, 1847 and died of consumption on October 5, 1848.
4. Frances Augusta Lufkin was born in Gloucester on January 6, 1849. She was named after her deceased sister. She died of typhoid on December 31, 1864.
5. Eliza J. Lufkin was born in Gloucester on October 3, 1850. She married Duncan Grant on July 5, 1868. She died in Gloucester of apoplexy of the brain on October 1, 1869.
6. Benjamin R. Lufkin was born on July 6, 1852 and died of Erysipelas on January 11, 1853.
7. William H. Lufkin was born in Gloucester on October 29, 1853. He was a mariner. He died of typhoid soon after his mother on January 4, 1870.
8. Emma R. Lufkin was born on July 1, 1857 and died of dysentery on October 29, 1858.
9. Emma R. Lufkin was born March 30, 1859, named after her deceased sister. She died on September 11, 1859. The cause of death was dropsy of the head.
10. Alphonso Lufkin was born on August 5, 1860. He worked as a teamster and died of consumption on Jan 1, 1879.
11. David Lufkin Jr. was born on June 3, 1862 and died of croup on October 8, 1863.
