1. Ellen Lowey Powers was the daughter of Robert Lowey and Elizabeth Benson. She was born in Liverpool, England in 1836. She married Richard Powers in Gloucester on July 7, 1855. she died in Gloucester on November 19, 1902.
2. Private Richard J. Powers was the son of Patrick and Mary Powers. He was born in Gloucester on May 7, 1827. He was in Company D, 32nd Regiment of the Massachusetts Volunteer Infantry. He was killed in action on August 21, 1864 in Weldon Railroad, Petersburg, Virginia.
3. Richard James Cummings Powers was the son of Ellen and Richard. He was born in Gloucester on July 30, 1861. He died in Gloucester on September 14, 1929.
4. Etta Frances Powers Bridges was the daughter of Richard and Ellen Powers. She was born in Gloucester on August 16, 1859. She married Elmer E. Bridges in Gloucester on July 3, 1886. She died in Gloucester on January 5, 1891. After her death her husband married Josephine D. Cook.
5. James H. Bridges was the son of Elmer Bridges and Josephine D. Cook. He was born in Gloucester on November 7, 1897. He died in Tewksbury, Massachusetts on August 30, 1931.
6. Evelyn Susan Bridges Finnerty was the daughter of Etta Powers and Elmer Bridges. She was born in Gloucester on July 14, 1888. She was married to Patrick Finnerty. She died in Gloucester on Oct 8, 1963.
7. Jane P. Woodwell was the daughter of Benjamin A. Woodwell and Mary E. Perkins. Mary was first married to Thomas Lowey, the brother of Ellen Lowey Powers. She was born in February of 1884 and died during a measles epidemic on December 14, 1884.
8. Benjamin Woodwell Jr. was the son of Mary E. Perkins and Benjamin Woodwell. He was born in Gloucester on July 21, 1880 and died there on August 19, 1881.
